Dr. Vishal Madaan joined the APA on August 1, 2022, as the Chief of Education & Deputy Medical Director. He has received the APA's Nancy Roeske award for excellence in medical student education and APA's Irma Bland award for excellence in resident education. Dr. Madaan has also served as Editor for the PRITE and Child PRITE exams for the past several years. He was inducted into the University of Virginia's Academy of Distinguished Educators in 2015.
